Psalms 86 - 93

Psalm 86

— The only Psalm of David in the 3rd book division.

-The Psalm is largely composed of quotations from other psalms showing the vast knowledge and familiarity of Scripture by David.

-The title for God Adonai “Lord” is prevalent in the psalm implying absolute Lordship and submission, 7 x psalm declares the excellence of God in time of distress,

-VS-1-5 The Lord is forgiving.

— VS—8-10 The Lord is great.

— VS-11-15 The Lord is compassionate.

-VS-16-17 The Lord is help and comfort.

86:3 Jesus cried unto Him who was able to save Him Heb.5:7.

86:8 God is unique and Incomparable, He alone is God.

86:11 Teach me - Teachers are scriptural but only

the H.S. can make it alive and true.

Unite my heart to fear Your name -

1. To do the will of God.
2. To receive all that God has.
3. To live in God’s love and peace.

86:12 The result of the Word and H.S. transforming him.

86:15 God is contrasted to the merciless men of VS-14, yet God knows everything about us and could justly condemn us.

Psalm 87

— A Psalm of the sons of Korah.

-A song declaring God’s sovereign delight and choosing of Zion.

— VS-1—3 The City

-VS-4—8 The citizens

-VS—7 The singing

87:1 Mountains — Plural because it is part of a mountain range.

-Holy because God chose to manifest Himself there.

87:3 Prophetic promises

87:4 God will acknowledge all who call on His name regardless of nationality or race.

-In Kingdom age all will come to Jerusalem Rev.21:22-27.

87:7 Rejoicing over spiritual life in Jerusalem.

Psalm 88

-A song of gloom and despair without any relief.
—A Psalm of the sons of Korah, to the chief musician.

-Set to, “Mehalath Leannoth” concerning the sickness?

-A contemplation or instruction of Heman the Ezralite, David’s musician 1Chron.2:6.

-VS-1—2 His petition

—VS—3—8 His condition

-VS-9—12 His urgency

—VS—13-18 His despair

88:1—8 He attributes his condition to God’s doing.

88:10—12 Once dead there will be no need for help.

88:15 Appears to be a life long affliction.

Psalm 89

-A contemplation or instruction of Ethan the Ezralite.

-Psalm dealing with the covenant and God’s faithfulness.

—VS-1—4 God’s faithfulness to Israel.

—VS—5-18 God’s faithfulness to creation.

—VS-19—37 God’s faithfulness to His covenant.

—VS—38-52 God’s faithfulness to His promise.

89:3—4 Act.2:29—31,15: 15—15, “2Sarn.7:13”.

89:8 God’s uniqueness and incomparableness.

89:14 God holds all the facts to every matter.

89:20 “Act.13.22—23”

89:27 First born - Col.1:15,Rev.1:5

89:29 Gal.3:16 Seed as of one.

Psalm 90—106

Is the fourth book corresponding to the book of Numbers dealing with unrest and wandering emphasizing worship.

-Dominant name is “Jehovah”, again appearing more than once in every psalm.

-Psalm 90—99 are known as Sabbath Psalms, from their use in the synagogue.

Psalm 90

-A prayer of Moses the man of God which declares the Eternal God and finite man.

—VS—1-8 The eternity of God.

-VS—7-12 The frailty of man.

-VS-13—17 The prayer of Moses.

90:1—2 Eternalhood of God Deut.33:27.

90:4 2Pet.3:8

90:5—fl Man’s temporal state.

90:7 The wilderness was the greatest death mark of Israel.

90:10 Life becomes more difficult in 80's yet man boasts as if it is due to him.

90:12 Our temporalness and frailty should teach us to take advantage of each day.

—I— 90:13—17 Petition for God's forgiveness and blessing.

Psalm 91

-Psalm of safety and security in God, being Messianic.

—VS-1—2 The proclamation of trust.

-VS—3-8 The promise of deliverance.

-VS-9—13 The promise of protection.

-VS 14-16 The promise by God.

91:1—2 Statement of fact.

91:4 Truth is our shield against condemnation of Satan and accusations of man.

91:11—12 Satan quoted out of context to Jesus in the wilderness temptation Mat.4:6,Lk.4:10—11.

—Heb.1:14 ministering spirits to...

Psalm 92

—A Psalm of praise to God for His faithful love.

-Song for the Sabbath day, used in the temple at the time of the morning sacrifice.

-VS-1—4 The benefit of thanks and praise.

-VS—5-11 The greatness of God.

-VS-12-15 The life of the saint.

92:1—2 Strength, confidence and contentment rather than weakness. doubt and murmuring as we focus on God not the circumstances.

92:5 Creation and dealings with man.

92:10—11 Living relationship with God.

92:12 Ps. 1 Withstanding storms and testings.

92:13 Growth, development and maturity Eph.4:11—16.

92:14 Vigors of life, faithful to declare God's faithfulness.

—5— Psalm 93

-A Psalm declaring the eternal reign of God.

—Called an enthronement psalm like Ps.47,96-99.

—VS-1—2 God is in control of His creation.

—VS-3—4 God Is mightier than His creation.

-VS-5 God is true and holy.

93:2 Ps.45:8,“Heb.1:8—9”.

93:3—4 Flood of Noah's day.
